

## Minutes of the Elk Run Cemetery Meeting

April 9, 1937

A meeting of the Elk Run Cemetery Association was called on April 9, 1937. The meeting was called to order by the President, Mr. E. B. Coffman. Members present were: A. B. Cover, C. E. Miller, H. T. Frey, and J. G. Harnesberger. A. E. Wyant, acting as secretary. \_\_\_\_\_ J. H. Sugarue having resigned as caretaker of the said cemetery on motion, Dudley Dodson was elected to take the place of the said Sugarue. On motion and carried that the said Dodson should be paid salary of \$32.00 dollars per month for six months of the year 1937, beginning April 15 and ending October 15. The said caretaker shall take chore of the said cemetery and keep the said graves and driveways in as good condition as possible according to all rules and bylaws therefore inacted by the said association. Also it was moved and seconded that the house in the cemetery lot should be leased to a suitable family for residential purposes together with the garden at the monthly rental of \$7.00 dollars per month payable in advance, and that the remises shall at all times be kept free from all \_\_\_\_\_ and that the cemetery board, or any members of said board shall have the privilege to enter the said tenements and building for inspection or to make repairs. This privilege shall apply to any one authorized by said board to do the same. One motion of A. B. Cover and seconded by Hugh Frey that the said Dodson should received pay for work actually done between the dates of Oct. 15, 1937 and April 15, 1938. No other matter before the board it adjourned \_\_\_\_\_ \_\_\_\_\_.
