

Minutes of the Elk Run Cemetery Meeting

March 24, 1939

The Trustees of the Elk Run Cemetery Association held a meeting March 24, 1939. Members present were: Dr. W. E. Kite, President, J. O. Harnesberger, H. T. Frey, C. E. Miller, and A. E. Wyant. The purpose of the meeting was to appoint our upkeep for one year and make some disposition of the cemetery home located in the said cemetery. On motion and seconded that Dudley Dodson should be appointed upkeep of the said cemetery for a term of six months at a monthly salary of \$25.00 dollars beginning about the first of April 1939 and payable the last of each month. The hired upkeep shall keep the cemetery at times free of grass, weeds, bushes, and fence rows free of bushes, briars, and to keep all tombstones intact as near as possible and graves filled when settled below level surfaces, and do all other work the said cemetery that is necessary to keep it in a decent condition also to mark all lot ____ with bricks, staks, or otherwise to design the owners of the said lots; all tools necessary for the said upkeep of the said Elk Run Cemetery to be furnished by the said Trustees. Also the dwelling house and garden in the cemetery may be accepted or rented by the said upkeep for a term of one year beginning about the first of April 1939. The said house and ____ the said 12 months the said ____ he turned over to the said natural wear and use excepted.
